Show pupils this video to introduce them to The United Nations and the Sustainable Development Goals.

Split the class into groups. Print and cut out the different United Nations Sustainable Development Goals and hand a set to each group. Alternatively, you could get them up on the whiteboard and have an interactive discussion.

In their groups get pupils to choose a Goal and discuss how active travel could help achieve it. For example, active travel helps improve people's health and wellbeing = SDG 3.



Description

Encourage pupils to take what they have learnt about active travel and the Sustainable Development Goals and write a speech to a Minister to highlight the importance of walking, wheeling, scooting and cycling. If needed, pupils can do this activity in pairs.

Imagine you had the chance to speak to a Minister about how active travel can help achieve the Sustainable Development Goals. What would you say?
